

## Pericles sets sail for the Fringe

Edinburgh-based theatre company Siege Perilous is preparing to wow lovers of classics visiting this year's Fringe Festival with its latest contemporary adaptation; Shakespeare's 'Pericles'.

Directed by Andy Corelli, the show follows the adventures of Pericles, the handsome Prince of Tyre and perhaps one of Shakespeare's lesser known heroes. The audience travel across 16 years with Pericles, inherently a 'good guy' from a privileged upbringing, on a series of fantastical experiences through his roller-coaster life as he attempts to keep ahead of an assassin.

The comedy and humour of this moving story is balanced with great tragedy and the darkness of family secrets, such as incest. The energy of the show is enhanced with pulsating music, slick dance moves, a brothel and a game show. It is being performed throughout the whole of the Fringe Festival at Sweet ECA (Sweet Upstairs).

Andy Corelli, who was invited to direct a new piece of writing at this year's NewWriting NewWorlds Festival in Glasgow, says: "Though it's not one of Shakespeare's better known plays, I have been amazed at how many in the acting community have worked on or know the play, yet the stock response from theatre goers is that they've never heard of it. I like the idea of taking something relatively obscure and seeing what can be done with it".

The production has been entirely created and sourced in Edinburgh, including actors, designers, and photographer, with all photos shot around Leith.
